RESOLUTION OF SUSAN PARKER ADOPTING EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR CBC OFFICERS

- WHEREAS**, the Comanche Nation is a federally recognized Indian Tribe with a Constitution approved and ratified by the Secretary of the Interior of the United States on January 9, 1967, to safeguard tribal rights, powers, and privileges to improve the economic, moral, educational, and health status of its members; and
- WHEREAS**, as defined in the Comanche Constitution Article IV §1 the Supreme Governing Body of this organization shall be the Comanche Tribal Council; and
- WHEREAS**, the Comanche Constitution, Articles VI, §7(j), and VII empower the Comanche Business Committee to conduct Elections for and on behalf of the Comanche Nation and to promulgate and enforce ordinances governing law and order; and
- WHEREAS**, the Comanche Constitution, Article VI §7 authorizes and states the duties, responsibilities and authorities of the business committee shall include [§7(b)] to determine qualifications of candidates nominated for office; and
- WHEREAS**, the Comanche Business Committee deems it advisable after formal discussion, review and approval by a referendum vote at large by the Comanche Tribal Council to adopt an educational requirement for Chairman, Vice-Chairman & Sec/Treasurer candidates to hold a minimum of a Bachelor's Degree in order to qualify as a candidate to run for these positions on the Business Committee.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Comanche Nation shall adopt an Educational Requirement of a Bachelor's Degree as a Qualification to run for the office of Chairman, Vice-Chairman & Sec/Treasurer hereby adopted and promulgated as the law governing the Comanche Nation, and shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
