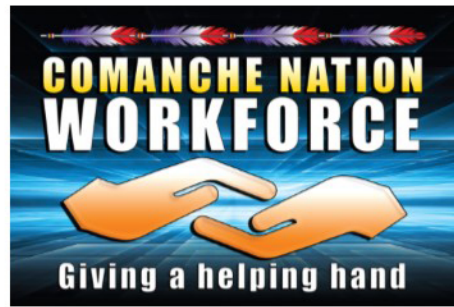


Comanche Nation Workforce



Phlebotomy I & II Course

March 26—April 18, 2018

Phlebotomy: Students gain hands-on experience in blood collection, specimen handling, venipuncture, finger stick techniques and more.

- Must possess a high school diploma or GED.
- Tuition, books and testing will be paid for by the Comanche Nation Workforce Program.
- A stipend in the amount of \$7.25 per hour for seat time spent in class will be provided.
- Classes will be taught at the Great Plains Technology Center, located in Lawton, OK.
- Applications will be accepted on a first come, first serve basis.
- **Application Deadline: March 16, 2018.**

In order to apply, please submit the following documents to the Comanche Nation Workforce office:

- A complete Comanche Nation Workforce application.
- Picture ID.
- CDIB (Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood).
- Social Security Card—or SSA letter to verify your SSN
- Proof of income (or letter of support).
- Proof of residence (Utility bill or letter address to you).
- Proof of public assistance (Food stamp card, SSI letter, etc.).
