

## Comanche Nation Elder Center “Action Plan as of March 17, 2020”

The Comanche Nation Elder Center is working to make a safe, proactive, response to the spread of the novel coronavirus Covid-19. Elder programs will continue to monitor the outbreak through the information put out daily by Comanche Nation regarding the status in Oklahoma. This and the recommendations from the Comanche Nation Administration/ Comanche Nation Department of Environmental services will determine our course of action.

Comanche Nation Elder Center will continue to provide healthy nutritious meals however we will cease congregate dining and serve it as a take-out drive-thru type of meal. We will continue to serve home delivered meals, which will give us an opportunity to see the needs of our Elders on the program. Priority of meals to those who are considered frail/disabled. While serving meals, we will observe current health precautions, such as gloves, masks and home delivered meals, we will knock and leave at the door, especially for those who are either self-quarantined or quarantined. We will leave the premise once we see the meal is obtained by recipient.

Comanche Nation Elder Center will continue to operate however we will operate via phone, email, fax or drop-off method using all the novel coronavirus Covid-19 precautions, such as gloves and masks. Due to health precautions we are limiting/restricting visitors.

Due to the novel coronavirus Covid-19 and high demand of congregate and home delivered meals, supplies are extremely limited, however, under FEMA supplies can be ordered and delivered to current elders on the program.

Comanche Nation Elder Center has listed the following people as essential employees/volunteers whom are needed to adequately operate the facility efficiently. Due to health concerns and issues of Sindy McNamar, Head Cook; Nancy Travis, Driver/Activities Coordinator and Carletta Tachawwickah, Cooks Assistant are deemed non-essential.
